

**UTILITY COMMITTEE**  
**Monday, June 6, 2022**

Call to Order – Alderperson Turchi called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. in the Common Council Chambers of Hartford City Hall, 109 North Main Street.

Public Comment Period – None.

Update on Electric Service Interruptions and Water Main Breaks – Director of Utilities Brian Rhodes provided an update on the following:

1. On June 2 around 4AM, there was an outage on High Street near State Street. The cause of this outage was an arrester failure. The line crew surveyed for damage and replaced the arrester.
2. On June 2 around 1:40PM, there was an outage that affected the entire Village of Slinger and parts of the city. Work was being done on the switch gear replacement program in Slinger. When re-energizing one of the replaced gears, a fault occurred which caused the outage. Power was restored in Hartford in 15-20 minutes and just under an hour in Slinger. There was a wiring problem inside the gear, which was corrected. This outage affected about 2500 customers.
3. On June 6 on Kettle Moraine Dr in Slinger, there was a cable termination that failed on the side of a pad mount transformer that caused an outage. The line crew replaced the termination and the transformer and restored power. This outage affected about 25 customers.

Update on private lead service lateral program – Director Rhodes explained that the program is just getting started. Contract documents are signed and notification letters went out to about 110 customers informing them of the project and what the function of both the city and the contracted excavating company will be. A pre-construction meeting is set for next week with a potential start date at the end of June.

Discussion and consideration of approving the 2021 Wastewater Treatment Plant Compliance Maintenance Annual Report – Sewer Utility Director Dave Piquett explained that this report is required by the DNR. The Hartford Wastewater Treatment Plant remains in full regulatory compliance for the 2021 reporting year. The plant should also be able to remain in the voluntary no action range for many years to come.

MOTION by Alderperson Carroll, seconded by Alderperson Sikora approving the 2021 Wastewater Treatment Plant Compliance Maintenance Annual Report.
